Industrial Worker from Chic-
-ago U.S.A. I am a steel
worker employed at the
B.H.P. steel works Port
Waratah and I hope you
will excuse my writing
as ^{hands are} my cramped and sore.

the Leaders openly support
Franco in Spain.

This is due to the Roman Catholic Church, having gained nearly all leading positions in the Labor Party. The Communist Party will not expose them because it would break the unity of the Party; but instead plead mournfully for a People's Front. One of the Communist Party Leaders died here recently and it said the Central Committee ordered them to get a parson to read the burial service which was done "a classic example of the United front."). The Comrats as we call here hate the sight of us and me in particular and have tried to molest me on several occasions generally ~~a~~ 5 or 6 together like a pack of wolves, but never one at a time.
