Your request, received on February 1, 2022, has been reviewed.

The Administration of the FSB of Russia for Vologodskaya Oblast has an archival criminal file № P-13422 for Vladimir Vladimirovich Barmash, born in 1881 and a native of Moscow.

According to the materials in his file, Vladimir Vladimirovich Barmash was sentenced at a Special Session of the NKVD of the USSR on May 9, 1935, to imprisonment in an ITL (Corrective Labour Camp) for three years, starting from January 25, 1935.

He was incarcerated in the Vologda Prison of the NKVD.

On September 15, 1937, a troika of the NKVD for Arkhangelskaya Oblast sentenced him to be shot, for "extolling the former tsarist regime among prisoners and for slandering the Soviet government and collective farms." The sentence was carried out on September 29, 1937.

By a decision rendered by the prosecutor for Vologodskaya Oblast on April 10, 1989, Vladimir Vladimirovich Barmash was rehabilitated.
